Adoption of Bill 741 as Ordinance 723: An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Fallon, Nevada, designated by the short title "2008 Sewer Bond Ordinance"; providing for the issuance of its registered, negotiable, sewer revenue improvement and refunding bond, series 2008, in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$7,500,000; stating the purposes for which the bond is to be issued; providing the form, terms and conditions thereof and covenants relating to the payment of said bond and the handling of funds; providing for the sale of the bond; securing its payment by a pledge of revenues derived from the sewer system of which the financed project is a part; ratifying action previously taken toward the issuance of said bond and effecting the purpose of its issuance; providing other matters relating thereto; and by declaring that this ordinance pertains to the sale, issuance and payment of the bond, providing for its adoption as if an emergency exists.
