

**MINUTES  
CITY OF FALLON

The Honorable City Council met in a regularly scheduled Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 7:00 p.m. He then requested everyone rise to pledge allegiance to the flag.

Mayor Tedford requested a moment of silence for the recent passing of former Churchill County Commissioner Cyril Shank.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the agenda had been posted in compliance with NRS requirements.

City Clerk Cordes advised the agenda was posted in compliance with NRS 241.

**Approval of Council meeting minutes for February 6, 2007 and February 16, 2007**

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any additions or corrections to the Council meeting minutes for February 6, 2007 and February 16, 2007.

No additions or corrections were noted.

Councilman Swan motioned to approve the Council meeting minutes for February 6, 2007 and February 16, 2007 as submitted, seconded by Councilman Erickson and unanimously approved.

Alcohol is not to be consumed on the property. The existing business has been in place for many years. They have met the conditions for licensing requirements. City Clerk Cordes recommended approval of this request.

Chief Brooks noted a typographical error in the body of the resolution and will follow up to ensure it is corrected.

Councilman Tewell noted that the residents in the area will appreciate the slower speed limit since there is an absence of sidewalks on the street.
