

**MINUTES

The Honorable City Council met in a regularly scheduled Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

City Clerk Cordes explained that Steven Hernandez and Margaret Smitten-Hernandez have requested an on-premises/unrestricted liquor license for Slanted Porch to be located at 310 South Taylor Street. All alcohol will be consumed on the premises. The property is properly zoned for this activity. The applicant will need to apply for a City business license and have it signed off by the City Building Inspector, Fire Marshal and Health Department before a liquor license would be issued. City Clerk Cordes recommended approval of this request.

Councilman Tewell inquired as to when the business would be open.

City Clerk Cordes replied that he was not sure.


Executive Session
