

**MINUTES

The Honorable City Council met in a special Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 8:30 a.m.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the agenda had been posted in compliance with NRS requirements.

City Clerk Cordes advised the agenda was posted in compliance with NRS 241.

**Adoption of recommendations of Angelou Economics Study of Military Gap Analysis**

Mayor Tedford advised that Eric Grimes of the Churchill Economic Development Authority (CEDA) needed this presented to the Council before the end of March. Back in October, Angelou Economics presented a preliminary report with recommendations to better utilize military establishments. He added that he was amazed at the amount of opportunity still available to communities with military installations. Mr. Rick Lattin is available today to answer any questions.

Mr. Lattin added that this report identified some areas where local vendors can provide business to the military base. Not many businesses are certified to work on the base and now those businesses can work with CEDA to get the required certifications.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the Council had any questions or comments.

Councilman Tewell noted that he sat in on the original presentation.

Councilman Swan advised that he also sat in on the original presentation.

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any public comments or questions.

No comments were noted.

Councilman Swan motioned to adopt the recommendations of Angelou Economics Study of Military Gap Analysis; seconded by Councilman Tewell and unanimously approved.

**Approval of an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement regarding the Western Nevada Home Consortium**

Mayor Tedford explained that this amendment simply changes a paragraph to bring the dates into the current year.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the Council had any comments or questions.

Councilman Swan noted a typographical error on the signature page. This information will be forwarded to the Western Nevada Home Consortium for correction.

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any public comments or questions.

No comments were noted.

Councilman Swan motioned to approve an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement regarding the Western Nevada Home Consortium; seconded by Councilman Tewell and unanimously approved.

**Adoption of Bill No. 742 as Ordinance No. 724: An Ordinance amending the City of Fallon Municipal Code Title 5, by amending certain sections and repealing certain sections**

Mayor Tedford explained that this amendment is required for fingerprint reporting requirements for workers in casinos and the licensing of liquor establishments. He noted that this ordinance still requires that liquor establishment licenses would come before the Council for review and approval. It would also come before the Council for revocation.

Councilman Tewell motioned to adopt Bill No. 742 as Ordinance No. 724: An Ordinance amending the City of Fallon Municipal Code Title 5, by amending certain sections and repealing certain sections; seconded by Councilman Swan and unanimously approved.

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any public comments.


No comments were noted.
