

**MINUTES

The Honorable City Council met in a special Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 1:00 p.m.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the agenda had been posted in compliance with NRS requirements.

Confirmation hearing for appointment of Leonard E. Mackedon as Deputy City Attorney

Mayor Tedford explained that this is a hearing to confirm the appointment of Leonard E. Mackedon as Deputy City Attorney.
