

**MINUTES

The Honorable City Council met in a regularly scheduled Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 7:00 p.m. He then requested everyone rise to pledge allegiance to the flag.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the agenda had been posted in compliance with NRS requirements.

Approval of Council meeting minutes for October 7, 2008

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any additions or corrections to the Council meeting minutes for October 7, 2008.

Councilman Swan motioned to approve the Council meeting minutes for October 7, 2008 as submitted, seconded by Councilman Erickson and unanimously approved.

Presentation of the Police Department Report for September 2008

Chief Gehman stated that he was pleased to represent the men and women of the Fallon Police Department with the presentation of the September monthly report. He added that the September numbers were in line with previous months with no special exceptions:

- Officers and staff were able to attend 88 hours of creditable training which includes the training of a patrol officer (Officer Jackson) to process crime scene evidence collection. This is intended to remove that responsibility from the detectives, allowing them to immediately conduct interviews and other investigative duties.
- We utilized the Volunteers in Police Service for 87 hours and Inv. Riley again provided an indoctrination lecture to newly stationed Navy personnel.
- Citizen survey results were mostly positive.

Mayor Tedford inquired if the Council had any comments or questions.

Councilman Tewell noted that there were more moving citations and fewer accidents.

Mayor Tedford thanked Chief Gehman for the report.
