Adoption of a final budget for June 30, 2011

City Clerk Cordes explained the City had a public hearing on the budget during its last regularly scheduled Council meeting on May 18, 2010. Today this Council action will require the City Council to adopt a final budget for June 30, 2011. He advised the budget had been on file and available for public inspection at the City Clerk's Office and the Churchill County Clerk's Office since April 15, 2010. He noted that no comments were received by the City Clerk's Office. He recommended adoption of this final budget.

Mayor Tedford noted that the City has historically been very frugal and conservative. We started preparing for these declining revenues three years ago and fortunately, with preplanning, we are not facing the dire circumstances that other small municipalities are experiencing.

Councilman Erickson motioned to adopt a final budget for June 30, 2011; seconded by Councilwoman Dahl and approved with a 3-0 vote by the Council.


Public Comments

No comments were noted.


