

**MINUTES

The Honorable City Council met in a regularly scheduled Council meeting on the above date in the Council Chambers, 55 West Williams Avenue, Fallon, Nevada.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Tedford at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Tedford requested a moment of silence for the recent passing of Mario Recanzone, former City Attorney and District Court Judge in Churchill County.

City Clerk Cordes advised that the agenda was posted in compliance with NRS 241.

Approval of Council meeting minutes for May 18, 2010 and June 1, 2010^e and Special Council meeting minutes for May 25, 2010

Mayor Tedford inquired if there were any additions or corrections to the Council meeting minutes for May 18, 2010 or June 1, 2010 or Special Council meeting minutes for May 25, 2010.

No additions or corrections were noted.

Councilman Erickson motioned to approve the Council meeting minutes for May 18, 2010 and June 1, 2010 and Special Council meeting minutes for May 25, 2010 as submitted, seconded by Councilwoman Dahl and approved with a 3-0 vote by the Council.

Presentation of the Police Department Report for May 2010

Chief Gehman stated that he was pleased to represent the men and women of the Fallon Police Department with the presentation of the May monthly report. He added that the May incidents and activities were in line with previous months with no exceptional variances.

- Officers and detectives attended 68 hours of creditable training.
- We utilized the Volunteers in Police Service for 79 hours and through the welfare assist account we provided two people with lodging.
- Detective Riley provided an indoctrination lecture to newly stationed Navy personnel.
- The citizen survey results were again highly positive and are available for Council review.

He advised that Energy Source had been selected as the best qualified consultant for our \$1.277 million energy grant.

Councilman Erickson: No comments.

Councilman Richardson: Noted that he had heard many compliments about the new playground equipment at Oats Park as well as the improvements to the baseball field. The field is in great condition; Fallon will be hosting tournaments soon and it will be nice to show off such a nice field.

Executive Session


Mayor Tedford tabled the executive session, as it was not needed at this time.
